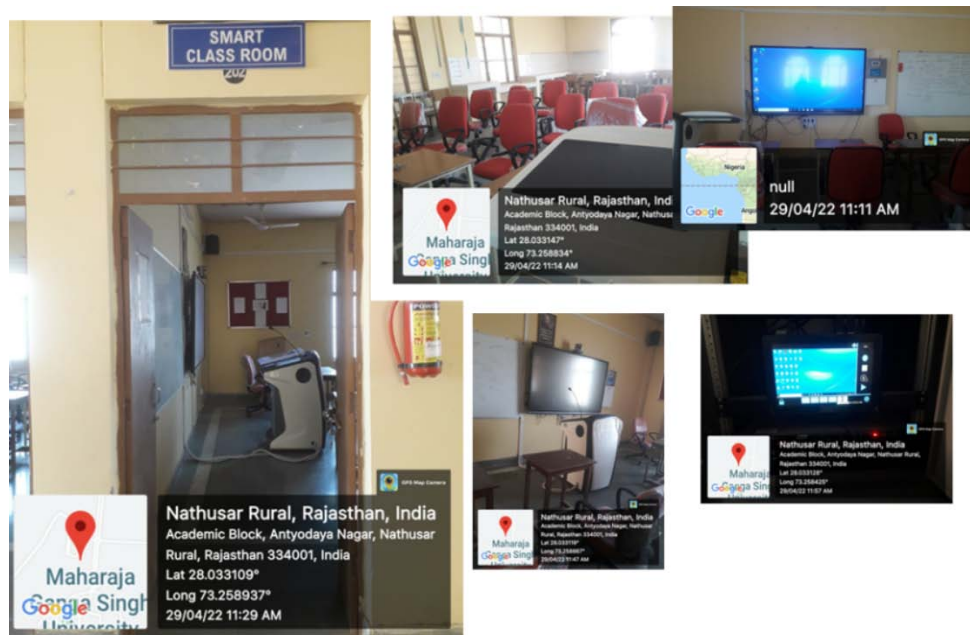
been given to all teaching and non-teaching staff for handling smart boards and digital podiums.



