

Stock Register Entry - i7 laptops and digital writing pads




Stock Register Entry - i5 laptops and digital writing pads


Stock Register Entry for Desktop Computers

12. Permanent Faculty






Budget of the University: Budget for the Lab equipment is highlighted


University regularly conducts cultural programs. However, due to the pandemic situation, all these activities were hampered. University will organize these activities after the things get normalized.
